In the late Edo period, when the wife of the 9th lord of the Saga Nabeshima clan was ill, she was attracted by the interesting patterns on the ceiling and applied them to weaving. The warp is strips of gold or silver foil covered washi paper, and weft, silk or brocade. Techniques such as plain weave, twill, and pattern weave are used to create elegance and luxurious warmth.

Learned from mother since elementary school. Studied under MASUDA, Michiko from 1970. Participated in public exhibitions since 1976. Nihon Gafu Exhibition (Nippu Prize, Memorial Prize, etc.), Kamakura Art Exhibition (Sasa-Rindo Prize, Member Prize, etc.)
