

≫ Dry-cell batteries (alkaline · manganese), lithium primary batteries (Coin type model numbers "CR", "BR", etc.), button-cell batteries ≪Box locations≫ Public facilities in the city such as City Office, Community Center, Central Library, Gymnasium, Recycling Exhibition Hall, etc.



≪Caution ≫

- Insulate button-cell batteries with cello tape or the like before disposal.
- Collection is also conducted by cooperating stores such as electronics stores.

Small Rechargeable Battery Collection Box

«Collection items» Mobile batteries, battery packs, etc. ≪Box locations≫ City Office, Recycling Exhibition Hall

- Insulate with cello tape or the like before disposal.
- Items with the recycling mark are also collected at cooperating stores such as electronics stores and supermarkets.

Used Small Household Electric Appliances Collection Box

«Collection items» Unwanted small household electric appliances (the following nine items) derived from home

- mobile phone (including PHS & smart phone) · portable music player
- · hand-held game machine · digital camera · portable video camera
- · portable car navigation · electronic dictionary · desk-top calculator
- AC adapter & codes
- Items that do not fit in the collection box (30 cm x 15 cm) are not accepted.



Used Fluorescent Lamps and Bulbs Collection Box

≪Collection items≫

Straight tube fluorescent lamps (120cm or shorter), circle tube fluorescent lamps or bulb-type fluorescent lamps from households. ≪Box locations≫



≪Caution≫

- To prevent being broken, place them in original wrapping or empty cases, or wrap them with newspapers, etc.
- Items other than fluorescent lamps and bulbs such as incandescent light bulbs, LED bulbs, etc. and broken lamps and bulbs can not be collected with this collection box. Dispose them on the collection day of "Ceramics/Glass/Metal Waste"



Items NOT Collected by Nakano City

Please dispose of it in one of the following ways:

- Pick-up from home by courier services (By the cooperation of the city's partner, Renet Japan Recycle, Inc., the collection of 1 box of disposing items which includes PC itself is free of charge.)
- Apply through their website (https://www.renet.jp/).
- Collection by manufactures, etc. (collection and recycling based on the Law for Promotion of Effective Utilization of Resources)

A collection/recycling fee will be charged for disposal. (Home-use PCs with the "PC recycling mark" can be disposed of without paying a collection/recycling fee.) Inquire contact information of each manufacture, collection method, fees, etc. to "PC 3R Promotion Association, Phone: 03-5282-7685".

Air-conditioner, TV, Refrigerator · Freezer, Washer · Cloth drier

There is a recycling and transportation charge for disposal. According to the Home Electric Appliances Recycling Law, manufactures do collection and recycling home appliances (including foreign, used or mail-order products). Please contact the store you purchased (or had it replaced). If you are not sure, please call the Home Appliances Recycle Reception Center, TEL: (0570)087200 (Navi Dial) to pick it up.

Difficult-to-Process or Hazardous Items

Flammable, harmful, or hazardous items are NOT collected by Nakano City. Please inquire with the store where the item was purchased or the manufacturer.

PET Bottle Automatic Collection Machine


☆Eligible to earning reward points

In order to efficiently collect colorless PET bottles recyclables derived from households, they are installed at supermarkets in the city (Dispose colored PET bottles as "Combustible waste" since this machine cannot process them). Remove caps and labels, and rinse the inside at home before bringing them. Put PET bottles into the machine without crushing them.

Compression reduce the volume, and CO₂ (carbon dioxide) emitted during collection and transportation. When you use this machine, you can collect reward points that can be exchanged for "shopping coupons".

Old Clothes/Old Fabrics

They are collected as resources with the Group Collection (except some area). Also, you can bring them into the Recycling Exhibition Hall (1.6-3 Matsugaoka / refer Contact Information on Page 4) during operation hours.



- Do not remove zippers or buttons.
- Items stuffed with cotton, and masks cannot be collected. Dispose them as "Combustible Waste".

Wet items cannot be recycled. For Group Collection, please put items out on a day that rain is not in the forecast all day.


Cooking Oil

«Collection items» Cooking vegetable oil (tempra oil, vegetable oil, olive oil, corn oil, etc.) which derive from household.

«Caution»

- Eliminate the dregs as much as possible and put oils in PET bottles, be sure to shut a lid on it, and take it to the Resource Collection Locations. (For unused oil bottles, bring in original bottles). - Please do not use glass bottles as they are easy to be broken.

Business Waste and Recyclables (fee-based service)

Business owners are responsible for the disposal of recyclables and waste derived from business operation such as offices or stores. The waste management must be conducted by the business (by contracting waste disposal companies, recycling businesses, etc.).

[When using Nakano City's collection]

Under the City's regulation, businesses are required to submit a form when requesting the City to collect waste. Businesses with no more than 20 employees or businesses that generate less than 50 kg of waste a day on average may fill out the Business



Waste Generation Form and dispose their waste at the City's collection sites. They must attach Waste Management Tickets to all waste. These tickets are available for purchase at convenience stores and stores with "Nakano City Waste Management Tickets are available" sign or at Nakano Waste Management Office.

litems to remember when requesting Nakano City collection

The city will issue a "Notification Certificate" to the business owners who submitted the notification and inform them of the "Business Owner Number".

Please write that number and "business name" (company name, shop name, etc.) on the Waste Management Ticket and attach it to the waste. Waste that does not have a proper Waste Management Ticket cannot be collected. If you live in the same place as the store (business office), please separate the store waste and household waste and put them out in separate bags.

Olf using a waste bin

Attach a Waste Management Ticket adequate for the amount of waste contained inside. Place the ticket inside the container on the item on the very top of the waste, or if you have kitchen scraps and cannot attach the ticket, attach the ticket on a piece of paper and place it on the very top of

If using a waste bag

Attach an adequate Waste Management Ticket for the size of the waste bag and attach it to a place that can be easily seen. For example, even if the waste bag is only half-full, please attach a ticket adequate for the size of the bag.

Items difficult to fit in a waste bag

■ Foamed polystyrene (Dispose as Recyclable Plastics)



Notes

1: If rechargeable products, spray cans, gas canisters, lighters, etc. are disposed together with other garbages, it may cause a fire in waste collection vehicles or waste processing facilities. Put it in a bag separate from other garbage, and indicate what the contents are. Do not make holes in spray cans and gas canisters.

Plastic Shopping Bag

- 2: Cutlery and broken bottles are dangerous. Wrap it in paper or cloth, put it in a bag separate from other garbage, and indicate what the contents are.
- 3: Mercury-containing products cannot be land filled, so they will be treated separately. Put it in a bag separate from other garbage, and indicate what the contents
- 4: Even if an item is made entirely of plastic, if it is uncleanable, it is handled as "Combustible Waste". If even one part of an item is made of material other than plastic, it cannot be disposed of as "Recyclable Plastics".

To prevent waste from spilling and scattering, please cooperate in the following manner when disposing of waste:

There are frequent accidents of spilling and scattering of contents on passersby

and neighboring houses when bags containing liquid tear when they are piled onto collection trucks.

•Liquids cannot be collected as waste. When disposing of liquids, please absorb the liquid with paper or cloth, or solidify it with a solidifying agent, and dispose of it on the collection day for "combustible waste"


• If you wish to dispose of items with contents that might spill or scatter, such as down or microbeads cushions, as "combustible waste", place the items in a separate bag and write the contents on the bag before disposal.





◆Depending on the conditions of strong winds, flooding, and snowfall, the collection time may be significantly delayed, and waste collection and placement of bottles, cans, and PET bottle's collection bins may be canceled.

◆We kindly ask for your cooperation in putting wastes out on the next collection day as much as possible.



◆ Even if a large amount of garbage is generated due to cleaning up the damaged house, it is important to thoroughly sort it. Spoilage items and items need to be controlled for hygiene are highly prioritize for collection. Please check the latest information before taking out the garbage.
